I've got a Hue Smart plug. In the Hue App it's always annoyingly been listed as Light, but I'm using to control a network switch in my home server lab, which I power down when not in use!

I've updated to the Matter support - so my Innr lights now appear in Homekit - yeah thx!

Seems the plug is still a Light post beta matter update - so shows up incorrectly in HomeKit. Any fix for this, I have an Eve Plug as well - but that shows in Homekit as expected.

I have the same problem in the Apple Home App. And because the Hue Smart Plug are not seen as an outlet, you cannot change in Properties the "Display as" between "Outlet", "Fan" and "Light". The old Philips LightWhites Plug work correctly.
