Changes in Shortcuts 2.1 Beta 2

- Added new actions: Create Alarm, Toggle Alarm, Start Timer, Measurement, Convert Measurement
- When running a shortcut from HomePod using Siri, media will now automatically playback from HomePod using AirPlay
- After sharing a shortcut you can now stop sharing by opening the iCloud link on iOS and choosing "Stop Sharing" in the Shortcuts app, removing the shortcut data from iCloud
- The Call and FaceTime actions now work from Siri without unlocking your phone
- Fixed an issue where some apps were missing from the Open App action
- Fixed an issue where shortcuts may become duplicated after syncing
- Fixed an issue where logging into Todoist may display an error message
- Fixed an issue where the Shortcuts app may crash when opening the editor
- Fixed issue where variables in Find and Filter actions may not be fully visible
